

Scripture Readings (ESV):

I Chronicles 16:7-36:

- ⁷ Then on that day David first appointed that thanksgiving be sung to the LORD by Asaph and his brothers.
- ⁸ Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon His name; make known His deeds among the peoples!
- ⁹ Sing to Him, sing praises to Him; tell of all His wondrous works!
- ¹⁰ Glory in His holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice!
- ¹¹ Seek the LORD and His strength; seek His presence continually!
- ¹² Remember the wondrous works that He has done, His miracles and the judgments He uttered,
- ¹³ O offspring of Israel His servant, children of Jacob, His chosen ones!
- ¹⁴ He is the LORD our God; His judgments are in all the earth.
- ¹⁵ Remember His covenant forever, the word that He commanded, for a thousand generations,
- ¹⁶ the covenant that He made with Abraham, His sworn promise to Isaac,
- ¹⁷ which He confirmed to Jacob as a statute, to Israel as an everlasting covenant,
- ¹⁸ saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan, as your portion for an inheritance."
- ¹⁹ When you were few in number, of little account, and sojourners in it,
- ²⁰ wandering from nation to nation, from one kingdom to another people,
- ²¹ He allowed no one to oppress them; He rebuked kings on their account,
- ²² saying, "Touch not My anointed ones, do My prophets no harm!"
- ²³ Sing to the LORD, all the earth! Tell of His salvation from day to day.
- ²⁴ Declare His glory among the nations, His marvelous works among all the peoples!
- ²⁵ For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, and He is to be feared above all gods.
- ²⁶ For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols,

but the LORD made the heavens.
²⁷ Splendor and majesty are before Him;
strength and joy are in His place.
²⁸ Ascribe to the LORD, O families of the peoples,
ascribe to the LORD glory and strength!
²⁹ Ascribe to the LORD the glory due His name;
bring an offering and come before Him!
Worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness;
³⁰ tremble before Him, all the earth;
yes, the world is established; it shall never be moved.
³¹ Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice,
and let them say among the nations, "The LORD reigns!"
³² Let the sea roar, and all that fills it;
let the field exult, and everything in it!
³³ Then shall the trees of the forest sing for joy
before the LORD, for He comes to judge the earth.
³⁴ Oh give thanks to the LORD, for He is good;
for His steadfast love endures forever!
³⁵ Say also:
"Save us, O God of our salvation,
and gather and deliver us from among the nations,
that we may give thanks to Your holy name
and glory in Your praise.
³⁶ Blessed be the LORD, the God of Israel,
from everlasting to everlasting!"
Then all the people said, "Amen!" and praised the LORD.

Luke 10:1-20:

¹After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them on ahead of Him, two by two, into every town and place where He Himself was about to go. ²And He said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. ³Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves. ⁴Carry no moneybag, no knapsack, no sandals, and greet no one on the road. ⁵Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace be to this house!' ⁶And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest upon him. But if not, it will return to you. ⁷And remain in the same house, eating and drinking what they provide, for the laborer deserves his wages. Do not go from house to house. ⁸Whenever you enter a town and they receive you, eat what is set before you. ⁹Heal the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' ¹⁰But whenever you

enter a town and they do not receive you, go into its streets and say, ¹¹ ‘Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet we wipe off against you. Nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near.’ ¹² I tell you, it will be more bearable on that day for Sodom than for that town.

¹³ “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. ¹⁴ But it will be more bearable in the judgment for Tyre and Sidon than for you. ¹⁵ And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You shall be brought down to Hades.

¹⁶ “The one who hears you hears Me, and the one who rejects you rejects Me, and the one who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me.”

¹⁷ The seventy-two returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name!” ¹⁸ And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. ¹⁹ Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you. ²⁰ Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”

Sermon: **Come on People Now**

1. How would you retell what Asaph said to the people then in **I Chronicles 16** to call people today to the cause of Christ and the Lord's ministry here at St. John's?
2. What aspects of St. John's would aid us in recruiting people to join the cause of Christ here? How could you help communicate that to people outside of the church?
