

Scripture Readings (ESV):

Philippians 4:2-9:

² I entreat Euodia and I entreat Syntyche to agree in the Lord. ³ Yes, I ask you also, true companion, help these women, who have labored side by side with me in the gospel together with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life.

⁴Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. ⁵Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; ⁶ do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

⁸ Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. ⁹ What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me—practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.

John 21:15-25:

¹⁵ When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "Feed My lambs." ¹⁶ He said to him a second time, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "Tend My sheep." ¹⁷ He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" and he said to Him, "Lord, You know everything; You know that I love You." Jesus said to him, "Feed My sheep. ¹⁸ Truly, truly, I say to you, when you were young, you used to dress yourself and walk wherever you wanted, but when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and another will dress you and carry you where you do not want to go." ¹⁹ (This He said to show by what kind of death He was to glorify God.) And after saying this He said to him, "Follow Me."

²⁰ Peter turned and saw the disciple whom Jesus loved following them, the one who also had leaned back against Him during the supper and had said, "Lord, who is it that is going to betray You?" ²¹ When Peter saw Him, he said to Jesus, "Lord, what about this man?" ²² Jesus said to him, "If it is My will that he remain until I come, what is that to you? You follow Me!" ²³ So the saying spread abroad among the brothers that this disciple was not to die; yet Jesus did not say to him that he was not to die, but, "If it is My will that he remain until I come, what is that to you?"

²⁴ This is the disciple who is bearing witness about these things, and who has written these things, and we know that his testimony is true.

²⁵ Now there are also many other things that Jesus did. Were every one of them to be written, I suppose that the world itself could not contain the books that would be written.

Sermon Notes 16 April 2023 Scripture: Philippians 4:2-9; John 21:15-25 Sermon: Put Into Practice

1. What difficult/uncomfortable thing is Jesus calling you to do to feed/care for His sheep and lambs? How is He challenging you to show you love Him by ministering for Him and following after Him?

- How can you reconcile with others or help others reconcile (Philippians 4:2-3) to bring unity to the church (perhaps in <u>worship</u>) to bring unity and rejoicing in the Lord (v 4) here?
- How do you demonstrate your gentleness/reasonableness to others (v 5)? How do you take all your anxiety to Christ in prayer, and how do you receive the peace of God in those times (v 6-7)?

4. Do you think and meditate on ALL the qualities in verse 8 so you can put into practice what you have learned and seen (v 9)? What can you do to better practice the biblical faith so that we can be the church we need and Christ desires? Do you believe if we (even if only a few in the church) did this, we would be a more vibrant and growing and evangelistic/discipling church?
