

Scripture Readings (ESV):

Hebrews 3:7-19:

⁷ Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says,

"Today, if you hear His voice,

⁸ do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness,

⁹ where your fathers put Me to the test and saw My works for forty years.

¹⁰ Therefore I was provoked with that generation,

and said, 'They always go astray in their heart;

they have not known My ways.'

¹¹ As I swore in My wrath,

'They shall not enter My rest.""

¹² Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. ¹³ But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. ¹⁴ For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. ¹⁵ As it is said,

"Today, if you hear His voice,

do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."

¹⁶ For who were those who heard and yet rebelled? Was it not all those who left Egypt led by Moses? ¹⁷ And with whom was He provoked for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? ¹⁸ And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who were disobedient? ¹⁹ So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief.

John 6:60-71:

⁶⁰ When many of His disciples heard it, they said, "This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?" ⁶¹ But Jesus, knowing in Himself that His disciples were grumbling about this, said to them, "Do you take offense at this? ⁶² Then what if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where He was before? ⁶³ It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you

are spirit and life. ⁶⁴ But there are some of you who do not believe." (For Jesus knew from the beginning who those were who did not believe, and who it was who would betray Him.) ⁶⁵ And He said, "This is why I told you that no one can come to Me unless it is granted him by the Father."

⁶⁶ After this many of His disciples turned back and no longer walked with Him. ⁶⁷ So Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you want to go away as well?" ⁶⁸ Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life, ⁶⁹ and we have believed, and have come to know, that You are the Holy One of God." ⁷⁰ Jesus answered them, "Did I not choose you, the twelve? And yet one of you is a devil." ⁷¹ He spoke of Judas the son of Simon Iscariot, for he, one of the twelve, was going to betray Him.



Sermon Notes 23 April 2023 Scripture: Hebrews 3:7-19; John 6:60-71 Sermon: Places to Turn

1. Why is it so easy to forget the power of the Gospel in our lives? How do we find it so easy to fall into the world and its ways?

2. How can you encourage others in the church to avoid sin's deceitfulness and to remember that they are partakers of Christ, and so should remain steadfast to the end (**Hebrews 3:13-14**)?

3. Did it surprise you to know Jesus "lost" so many followers in His ministry (John 6:66)? How does Jesus model of focusing on the faithful remnant encourage you? How does His willingness to minister to His betrayer Judas encourage you to encourage others to avoid sin and deceitfulness (John 6:70-71)?

4. Who will you seek out to encourage you to avoid sin? Who will you encourage to do likewise? How will you do this to impact the whole church and not just your circle within the congregation?
