Scripture Readings (ESV):

Numbers 14:1-12:

¹ Then all the congregation raised a loud cry, and the people wept that night. ² And all the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron. The whole congregation said to them, "Would that we had died in the land of Egypt! Or would that we had died in this wilderness! ³ Why is the LORD bringing us into this land, to fall by the sword? Our wives and our little ones will become a prey. Would it not be better for us to go back to Egypt?" ⁴ And they said to one another, "Let us choose a leader and go back to Egypt."

⁵ Then Moses and Aaron fell on their faces before all the assembly of the congregation of the people of Israel. ⁶ And Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, who were among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes ⁷ and said to all the congregation of the people of Israel, "The land, which we passed through to spy it out, is an exceedingly good land. 8 If the LORD delights in us, He will bring us into this land and give it to us, a land that flows with milk and honey. ⁹ Only do not rebel against the LORD. And do not fear the people of the land, for they are bread for us. Their protection is removed from them, and the LORD is with us; do not fear them." 10 Then all the congregation said to stone them with stones. But the glory of the LORD appeared at the tent of meeting to all the people of Israel. ¹¹ And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will this people despise Me? And how long will they not believe in Me, in spite of all the signs that I have done among them? ¹² I will strike them with the pestilence and disinherit them, and I will make of you a nation greater and mightier than thev."

Luke 19:41-44:

⁴¹ And when He drew near and saw the city, He wept over it, ⁴² saying, "Would that you, even you, had known on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. ⁴³ For the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up a barricade around you and surround you and hem you in on every side ⁴⁴ and tear you down to the ground, you and your children within you. And they will not leave one stone upon another in you, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Scripture: Numbers 14:1-12; Luke 19:41-44

Sermon: Earned Ire

1.	Why did Jesus weep over Jerusalem? For whom do you weep and why? What does that spur you to do?
2.	How did Moses and Aaron and Joshua and Caleb respond to the people opposing God's plan? How could you apply that when reacting to others in the church or community who may not agree with you?
3.	How did Joshua and Caleb attempt to persuade the people to change their minds? What reminders do we as a church need to motivate people to follow God's calling for our church in mission and ministry?
4.	Do God's words in Numbers 14:11-12 surprise you? What did you expect from Him? How is God challenging the people? (Next week, we will see Moses' response to God's words, and a model for our response.)
