
Scripture Readings (ESV):

I Corinthians 2:1-5:

¹And I, when I came to you, brothers, did not come proclaiming to you the testimony of God with lofty speech or wisdom. ² For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified. ³ And I was with you in weakness and in fear and much trembling, ⁴ and my speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, ⁵ so that your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.

John 16:29-33:

²⁹ His disciples said, "Ah, now You are speaking plainly and not using figurative speech! ³⁰ Now we know that You know all things and do not need anyone to question You; this is why we believe that You came from God." ³¹ Jesus answered them, "Do you now believe? ³² Behold, the hour is coming, indeed it has come, when you will be scattered, each to his own home, and will leave Me alone. Yet I am not alone, for the Father is with Me. ³³ I have said these things to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."



Sermon Notes 04 February 2024 Scripture: I Corinthians 2:1-5; John 16:29-33 Sermon: Christus Victor

1. What does the concept of Christus Victor mean to you? Does it challenge the idea of substitutionary atonement for you, or does it give a deeper understanding of Christ's work on the Cross?

 How do the supporting scriptures (Luke 4:18; Ephesians 4:8; I Corinthians 15:25; I John 3:8; and Genesis 3:15) help you to understand Jesus as Christus Victor?

- Even though Jesus is Christus Victor, how are we to live in this world? How did Paul model this stature and way of living (I Corinthians 2:4-5)?
- 4. What did Jesus tell us to expect in this world? What then gives us peace and hope (John 16:33)? How, then, would you define the peace and hope you find in Jesus? How does that help you to live out your faith?


