Free Will Offering – Indian Lake Tornado Relief Fund

All donations tonight will go to the Indian Lake Tornado Relief Fund. The United Way of Logan County has launched the Indian Lake Tornado Relief Fund to help meet the immediate and long-term needs of Logan County families impacted by the March 14 storm. To date, \$87,347.16 has been used to purchase roofing materials, generators, portable storage units, provide transportation, prescription medication, set up two Multi-Agency Resource Centers, and provide specialized assistance to clients of a mental health agency and the Logan County Cancer Society. Any agency involved in providing direct relief to provide for basic immediate needs of tornado victims (food, clothing, shelter, transportation, prescriptions) can apply for funding online or by calling United Way at (937) 592-2886.

In the coming weeks, they will be working with the EMA and other local organizations to identify unmet needs of victims and provide help in those areas.
